DESCRIPTION OF SECTIONS

SECTION A

Landscape, seascape or urban-scape in a traditional or contemporary style, in any medium the prominent medium to be paint.

SECTION B

Still Life, A work depicting any inanimate object which can be natural or manmade in any medium

SECTION C

Figurative/Portrait – Works to be representational of any, human form, portrait, animal in any medium

SECTION D

Abstract - A work being non-representational, subject not recognisable, in any medium

SECTION E - Restricted to KAS Members

Local Kiama LGA - Work must be a recognisable subject within KIAMA LGA.

SECTION F - Restricted to High School Students, years 10,11,12 Any subject or medium

PEOPLE'S CHOICE AWARD

Most popular artwork selected by the people attending the exhibition.

HANGING REQUIREMENTS

- All entries are to have a legible label on the back stating.
 Name, Medium, Title, Section, and Selling Price.
- Attach D rings 10cm from the top (less for smaller works), ideally facing up, with a minimum 1.5cm space inside the ring for easy hook insertion.
- Attach cord or coated wire, leaving space at the D ring for the hook. Use extra generous size D rings on larger or heavier paintings.
- · Present dry, professionally finished artworks.
- Artwork with poor or unsafe framing will not be hung.
- Only artworks that meet the hanging criteria will be accepted.

COMMISSION ON SALES: Thirty percent on all sales

INSURANCE

Kiama Art Society will oversee all works with care. We are not liable for any loss, damage or breakage of exhibits during transit or exhibition.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- Entry fee is \$30 per entry for members, \$40 per entry for non-members. Section F is free of charge.
- Limit of 4 entries per artist, with only 2 in any one section.
- Size: Maximum length on any side can be no more than 122cm (48" including frame)
- All artworks are to be for sale (minimum price is \$400) not previously shown in a KAS Annual Exhibition and completed within the last 2 years.
- Each artwork can only win one prize, except of the people's choice award.
- Diptychs and Triptychs count as one work if presented unified as one piece, provided they fit within the size criteria.
- Photographic works, reproductions, or digitally enhanced submissions will not be accepted.
- All artwork must be original and made by humans without Al tools.
- Entries that do not meet requirements will not be displayed.
- In the event of a dispute over interpretation entry conditions or refusal of an exhibit, the decision of the Kiama Art Society will be binding on all parties.

COPYRIGHT

- All artists must warrant that they are the original author of the work, and that to the best of their knowledge, it does not infringe the copyright or moral rights of any third party.
- Artists grant the Kiama Art Society the right to reproduce images of works for promotion and publicity for KAS and future KAS Exhibitions.
