IMPRESS– AN INTRODUCTION TO RELIEF PRINTMAKING.

Join Suzanne Walker for an introduction to Relief Printmaking. The second of a series in Printmaking.

Suzanne will guide you through foundation processes to create an edition of Relief Prints.

A Relief Print is a technique where the printing surface is cut away so that the image alone appears raised on the surface. The raised areas of the printing surface are inked and printed. While the areas cut away do not pick up the ink. This is a simple form of Printmaking that can be reproduced in editions.

This will be a two-day workshop where you will be introduced to printmaking concepts and use easy to carve rubber to create an edition of prints.
